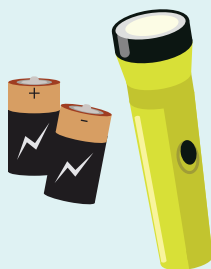


Home Hurricane Tips

- ☐ Keep trees & shrubbery trimmed
- ☐ Keep storm prep materials on hand such as plywood, tarps, straps, mounting hardware, flare, duct tape and fire extinguisher
- ☐ Minimize and store what could become flying debris
- ☐ Inspect generator & store gasoline for at least 7 days

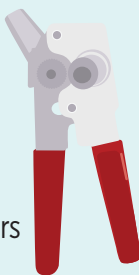


Hurricane Check List

- ID, passport & other important documents ☐
- Cash & Credit Cards ☐
- Cell phone & portable chargers ☐
- Spare car & home keys ☐
- Flashlight & extra batteries ☐
- Mosquito repellant ☐
- Personal hygiene items ☐
- Clothing & footwear ☐
- Childrens items: toys, books, puzzles ☐
- Infants/babies: diapers, wipes, formula, bottles ☐
- Prescription medicine, contact solution, spare eyeglasses, medical supplies ☐
- First Aid Kit ☐

Food & Water

- ☐ 7 day supply of water, one gallon per person, per day
- ☐ 7 day supply of non-perishable foods
- ☐ Fruit- canned, dried
- ☐ Meats- canned, dried
- ☐ Vegetables- canned
- ☐ Juices
- ☐ Peanut butter
- ☐ Crackers
- ☐ Soups- canned
- ☐ Nuts, Granola or Energy bars
- ☐ Manual can opener



Tips for Pet Owners

- Pet medications & records ☐
- 7 day supply Water, treats & food (in an airtight container) ☐
- Picture of you and your pet should you become separated ☐
- Crate/carrier/bedding labeled with your contact information ☐
- Toys, blankets, leash, collar and harness ☐
- Litter, litter box, scoop and/or newspaper, plastic trash bags ☐

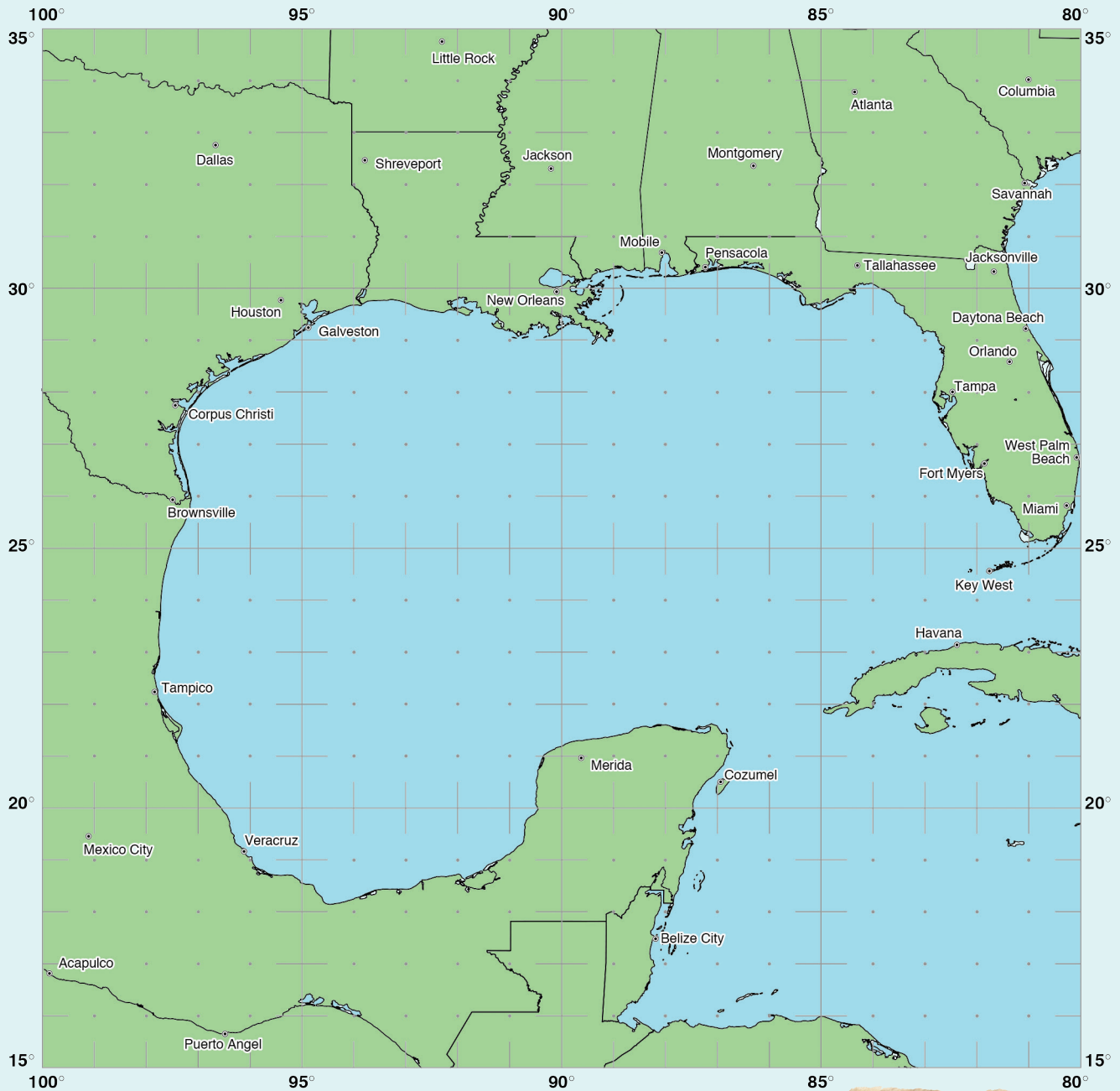
